

PCOC Meeting Minutes – Sept. 14, 2019

We reviewed the recommendations from our previous meeting regarding the use of the new ball machine and rebounder wall. These two machines will be for members only. The following rules/guidelines were voted on and passed unanimously.

1. A member must take a class on proper use and storage prior to usage. Several classes will be offered to accommodate members.
2. A sign up sheet will be posted inside the shed. Members may sign up no more than 24 hours in advance. Members will sign a machine out, and in when done.
3. During club play time, the drill court will only be available until 4 or more players are waiting for an open court. There will be no drill court available on Saturday mornings or during novice play on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
4. The machines may be used during public time as well. If using machines during public time, the shed doors should be closed once equipment is out, and members are encouraged to pay periodic attention to the shed. Upon completion of play, the equipment must be returned to the shed and the doors locked. The rebounder wall must be secured to the outside of the shed and properly covered up.
5. A machine may not be used for more than an hour unless no one else has signed up.
6. An information/setting sheet will be available with the machine and an instructional video will be available on the website.
7. While using the machine, if a problem arises or something malfunctions, do not attempt to fix it. Stop play and return the machine to the shed. Contact Kendal Wake at the number posted on the sign up sheet.

There was a large turnout for the skill clinics recently offered by Kendal and he will attempt to offer this training again in the future. He is also working to tentatively put together a weekend clinic in October that would be taught by professionals with members paying to attend. This clinic will be held at the Boys and Girls Club. Further details will be announced as they become available.

The PCOC will tentatively schedule indoor league play after the first of the year.
